

Overview

The SJSU Premier Wi-Fi service transmits your data across a secure, encrypted connection. This ensures that your data will not be compromised as it is transmitted wirelessly through the air from your computer to the network.

The San José State Premier Wi-Fi Service uses WPA2 Enterprise (Wi-Fi Protected Access) technology that causes all data to be securely encrypted while traveling through the wireless network. We strongly recommend the use of the SJSU Premier Wi-Fi service for all wireless network transactions.

Mac OS X Configuration Instructions

This guide demonstrates how to configure your Mac OS X for SJSU Premiere Wi-Fi services.

1. Select Join Other Network from the Airport icon in the menu bar.



2. Enter requested information per Network Settings table (below).
3. Click the Join button.



Network Settings

Field Name	Description
Network Name	Enter SJSU_premier.
Security	Select WPA2- Enterprise.
User Name	Enter your SJSUOne ID.
Password	Enter your SJSUOne password.

4. Click the Continue button to accept the certificate.

Your computer is now connected to the SJSU wireless network via the SJSU Premier Wi-Fi service.
